1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose of this Non-Technical Summary

1.1.1 This report provides a summary, in non-technical language, of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) undertaken in support of a planning application for proposed Energy Recovery Park (ERP) at Killoch, located off the A70 between Ayr and Cumnock in East Ayrshire.

1.1.2 This Non-Technical Summary (NTS) has been prepared by Wardell Armstrong LLP on behalf of Barr Environmental Limited (hereafter referred to as 'Barr'). The full report known as the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) has been submitted with the planning application and describes the proposal and provides an assessment of the likely environmental effects that may arise from the construction and operation of the ERP.

1.1.3 This NTS provides a brief description of the site and the proposed development, before summarising the environmental assessments undertaken in support of the application. Anyone with interest in exploring the specific findings of the EIA can refer to the full EIAR.

1.2 Introduction to the Proposed Development

1.2.1 The site is located within the administrative area of East Ayrshire Council (EAC). **Figure 1.1** illustrates the location of the site, and the planning application boundary.
